## **PRESS RELEASE**

### **Locust Street**

On Wednesday, March 25, 2008 at approximately 6:30pm a 12 year old boy was approached while riding his bicycle by occupants of a green, Buick LeSabre type motor vehicle on Locust Street in Holliston, MA. The occupants of the vehicle were described as being in their late teens or early twenties and told the boy to get into the car. The boy, correctly, rode back to his friend's house as the car followed him. When the boy arrived at his friend's house, the car made a u-turn and sped off.

The same boy reports the same car drove down Locust Street again on Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup> at approximately 3:30PM. As the car approached, the driver began to roll down the window and the youth turned immediately into a driveway as the car drove away. The car is described as a Buick LeSabre type, green in color with tinted windows, and a dent on the driver's side rear door. The operator of the car was wearing a hat and there were at least three people inside the car.

The incident was reported to the Holliston Police Department on Thursday, March 26<sup>th</sup> and a teletype was sent out to area police departments. The Holliston Police Department is continuing to investigate this incident. All schools were notified on Friday, March 27<sup>th</sup> and made aware of the incident.

This is an excellent opportunity to talk to you children about being aware of their surroundings and if approached by a stranger to get away immediately and to tell an adult.
