Residential Breaking & Entering

On December 30, 2008, at approximately 9:00am, a resident reported suspicious activity in which a 17 year old female woke to the sounds of a male calling "Hello, Hello, is there anyone home." She encountered a white male in the kitchen area who inquired about a studio apartment for rent. After informing him there was no apartment for rent, he immediately left the area.

Later this same day, a third Holliston resident reported that her pocketbook was stolen from her kitchen and entry is believed to have been gained via an unlocked side door.

The suspect was described as a white male, approximately 5' 7" tall, medium build, unshaven, short dirty blonde hair in his 40's. He was last seen wearing a white baseball hat, blue jeans, and brown Timberland boots. He was operating a dark green, two door pick up truck with a black cap and square windows. The make and model of the vehicle are unknown at this time.

Residents are asked to be aware of these events and to call the police if they encounter a similar situation.

This matter remains under investigation.
